

## Student Affairs Information and Research Office (SAIRO)

### Survey Data

SAIRO administers several surveys aimed at understanding the complexities of the student experience. Each survey page provides information about the survey content, administration, and access to reports.

### **Entering Student Survey (ESS)**

Provides baseline data about the new student population (first year and transfer students) as they enter UCLA. The survey is administered every two years to all incoming students. It includes information about past and anticipated activities and engagement, skills and abilities, interactions with others, perceptions of the college experience, health and well-being, campus climate, finances and basic needs, and background and characteristics (*click here to access more information about ESS*).

### UC Undergraduate Experience Survey (UCUES)

This survey provides an in-depth examination of the undergraduate experience. It is administered every two years in the spring to all enrolled undergraduate students in the UC system and includes content on background and demographic characteristics, academic experiences, co-curricular involvement, aspects of intellectual and personal development, civic engagement, and student service utilization and satisfaction (*click here to access information about UCUES*).

### First Destination Survey (FDS)

FDS is an online survey that is administered annually at UCLA. It provides comprehensive data that can be used to accurately inform and shape the career expectations of current undergraduates, new graduates, alumni, and prospective students. Survey content includes post-graduate plans for employment and continuing education, internship placement, quality of post-graduate readiness, and the resources used to find employment and/or internships (*click here for more information about FDS*).

### National College Health Assessment (NCHA)

NCHA is a nationally recognized survey that collects data on the knowledge, attitudes, beliefs, and health behaviors of randomly selected undergraduate and graduate students. It is administered every two years in the fall (*click here for more information NCHA*).

### Data Dashboard Hub

Allows users to explore existing data through interactive dashboards. Explore topics such as health and wellness, student experience, student demographics, etc. (*click here to access Dashboard Data Hub*).



### Academic Planning & Budget | Campus Statistics

Academic Planning and Budget provides several Tableau dashboards covering topics such as UCLA's admissions reporting, degrees awarded, enrollment trends, retention, graduation, student outcomes, and workforce-related data, among others. The Undergraduate Education Division compiles an Undergraduate Profile that provides information about new firstyear students, transfer students, and the overall undergraduate population at UCLA.
