PAST YEAR EXPERIENCES

**55.2%** of students rated their average stress level as "high or very high"



# **31.9%** of students indicated feeling depressed, stressed or anxious as an obstacle to their academic success, "often or very often"

**60.9%** of students are "concerned or very concerned" about being overwhelmed with all the things they're expected to do (socially and academically)
