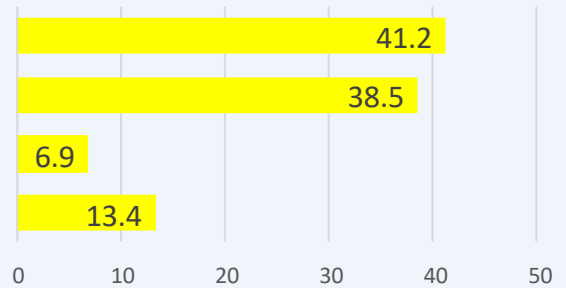

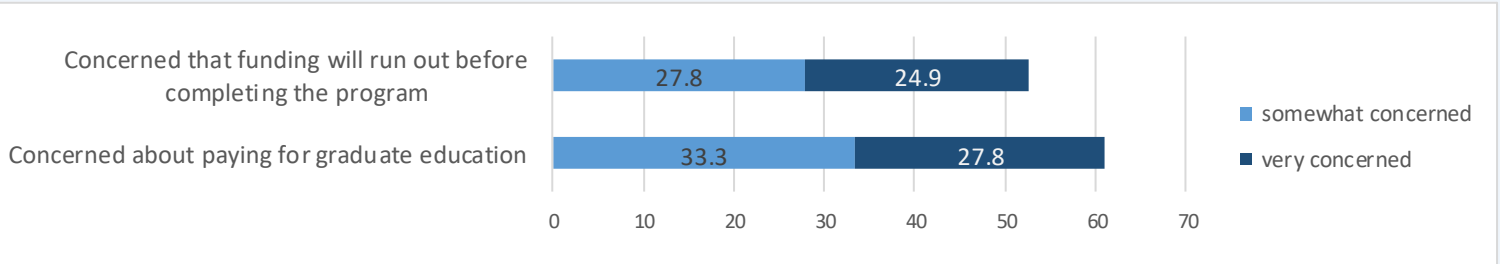

## CAMPUS CLIMATE Treatment in their program (% "agree" or "strongly agree")

- 86.3%** reported those in the program are respected regardless of their **race/ethnicity**
- 89.7%** reported those in the program are respected regardless of their **citizenship status**
- 84.2%** reported those in the program are respected regardless of their **gender**
- 80.0%** reported those in the program are treated **equitably** and **fairly** by **faculty**

## INTERACTIONS WITH OTHERS

Extent to which students engaged with people who are different than them % report that "most of the time" or "always"

- 66.3% shared a meal or socialized with someone different
- 79.3% interacted with someone different in class
- 71.4% discussed academic work or research outside of class
- 45.0% discussed topics about which you had different opinions

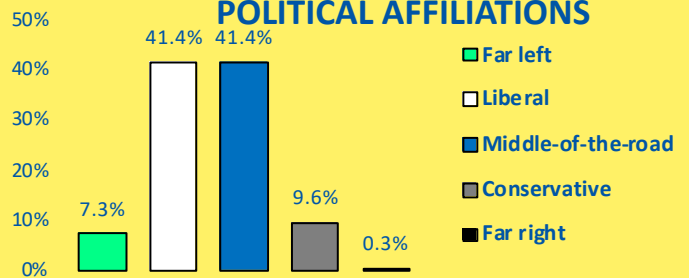
